We knew they needed a special home to get lots of special care, so we reached out to one of our many partners and here is their story 3 years later. Take the Lead Animal Rescue got the call 3 years ago to take them and they did. A foster, Ed Laumeyer, jumped to action and drove the long trip to rescue them. The Rescue became attached to the duo and decided not to place Buddy & Chico up for adoption but made them part of their family. Both dogs give us so much! They are both over 20 and act like puppies!

Buddy, the black Chihuahua, is known as "killer"! As wild turkeys appear in the yard, he charges snarling all the way! He is in hot pursuit! He has to have his ducks in a row before he eats! He looks at the food, drinks, goes to the bathroom, looks at the food and in about 15 minutes eats. He eats separately so as not to be disturbed!

Chico sleeps with his master and waits to be put to bed. Buddy chooses to sleep on one of many dog beds. He rolls up in a blanket like a tootsie roll. When he can't be found we go unroll blankets! Both dogs get massages at bedtime and before getting up to get the blood rolling! Chico shows no signs of arthritis and Buddy is a little stiff.

Both had horrible teeth, had dentals and are pretty much toothless. They enjoy soft homemade foods and receive organic olive oil and vitamins. Some days Buddy likes organic chicken broth on his. It will be sad when they are gone, but, we will have many fun memories. Now, they are giving more to us than we could ever give to them!!

Spay/Neuter Assistance – We aid families who have a financial hardship. Our Spay the Mom Cat program pays 100% of the spay cost.

Pet Food Bank – Helps people who may have fallen on hard times and occasionally need help feeding their pets. We help, on a temporary basis, pets in need.

Emergency Sheltering – We offer temporary boarding to those in shelters, domestic violence or disaster cases.

Volunteer – People volunteer here at the shelter, at offsites or at fund-raising events. If interested go to our website and click the Get Involved tab.

Breed Rescue – We work with shelters/rescues to find homes for pets struggling to get adopted. It may be special needs, length of stay, older or just harder to place pets.
