A few tips to keep your pet warm and safe this winter . . .

Winter is coming and with it, snow, ice and those nasty whirling gusts of freezing air. Don't be left out in the cold on properly caring for your pets during winter months. Just like warmer summer temperatures cold weather poses potential health and safety risks to animals. With that in mind here are tips to help keep your pets warm and safe this winter.

- 1. Never leave your pet alone locked in a cold car for a long period of time.
- 2. Put a doggy sweater on smaller short-haired pets for short walks, maybe even booties.
- 3. Use pet friendly ice melt and never let your pet off leash on ice or snow. Pets can slip and fall and possibly get hurt.

- 4. Antifreeze has a sweet taste that attracts pets, but is a deadly poison. Wipe up any spills.
- 5. Shovel an area for your pet to relieve themselves so they aren't walking in snow drifts.
- 6. Avoid exposing your pet to long periods outdoor, they are just as susceptible to frostbite and hypothermia as people.
- 7. Watch your pet's food intake and always have fresh water available.
- 8. Check your pets' paws for cracks or redness between toes and use petroleum jelly for paw protectant.

And always report if you see winter outdoor animal neglect.

SHELTER DIVERSION THROUGH PET RETENTION

We have a great facility and work hard to provide the best possible care for those that come to us, but a shelter or any new environment is still a stressful place for some pets. There is a shift in the animal welfare industry to divert animals from entering the rescue/ shelter systems when possible. That reserves the space and resources for the animals that need it most.

Our vision is to bring people and pets together and keep them together. Our Pet Retention Program is intended to provide assistance and resources to pet owners who wish to keep their pets but are experiencing a hardship. Our focus is to provide programs and services to the Siouxland community, and continually expand on our pet retention programs.

Home is the best environment for every pet. But we also know there are many reasons this is not always possible. We are here to help people and pets who need us in more than one way, and encourage responsible pet ownership. In 2020 we touched the lives of thousands of people, pets – families.
