Did You Know?

Several area veterinarians donate their time to come to the shelter weekly to do rabies vaccines, health checks and treat sick/injured animals. They include Dr Michelle Bader, Dr Tammy Loberg, Dr Pam Cuevas, Dr Steven Merritt and Dr Chad Anema. A huge thank you! Even with all the free vet care and assistance we spent \$26,523.51 in 2022 to treat sick or injured animals in our care.

In 2022 our pet retention services, keeping people, pets – families together, helped with veterinary costs in the amount of \$15,420.58. this program helped 96 families.

We also assisted non-shelter adopted spay/neuter surgeries for those with a financial need in the amount of \$22,094.27.
