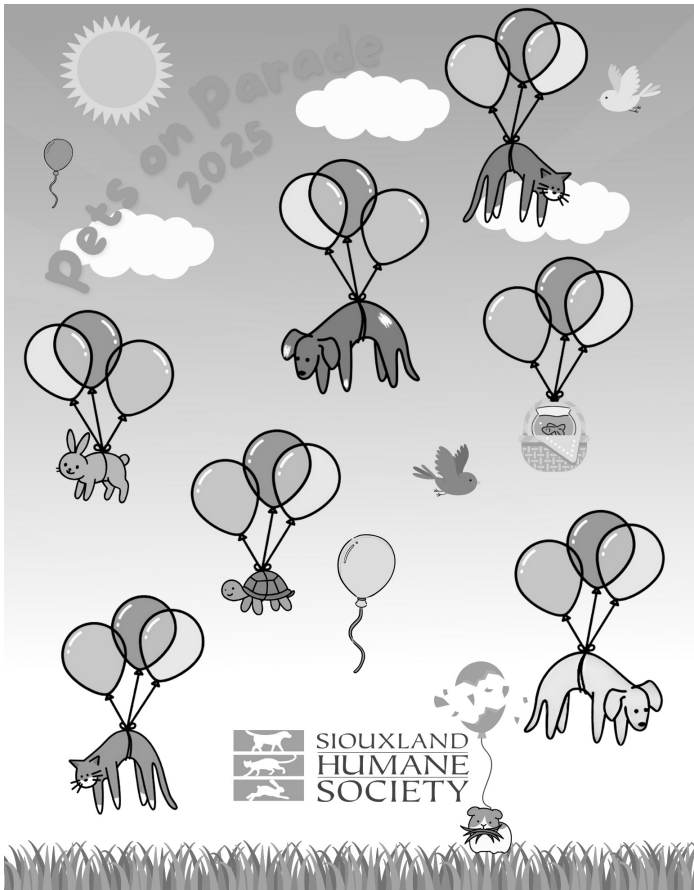

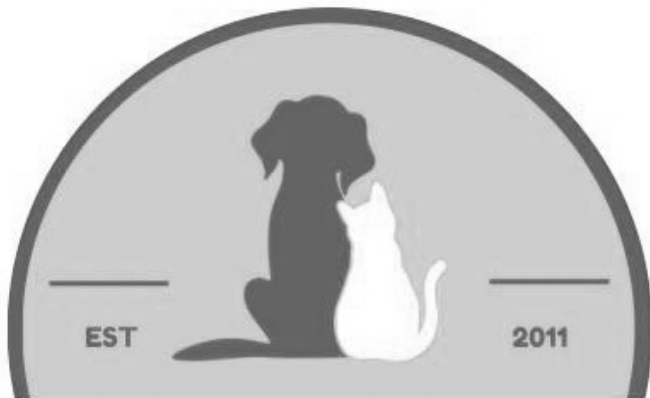

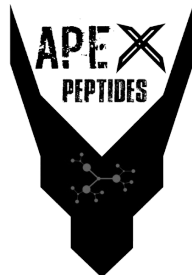

DIRECTOR LETTER

As you read this, I will have just celebrated 30 years working for the shelter! Over the years I have gained a wealth of experience and have seen many changes in animal welfare practices. I was hired in late August of 1995. We provided very basic animal care in a run-down shelter. There were only 3-4 employees. We euthanized hundreds of pets that year and on a very small budget we ran \$27,000.00 in the hole, with a grim future in sight. In 30 years we have grown and improved so much! We have more sophisticated approaches like enrichment programs, specialized training, and an increased focus on animal behavior. We have a smart highly trained staff of 19 that I am so appreciative of! In 2024 we were nationally recognized as a leading no-kill shelter with a 99.06% live release rate! For years our budget has been balanced and has even grown, enabling us to provide many programs and services to the community!

We have seen a shift in public perception, with more emphasis on adoption. We have seen a shift to helping people, pets and families stay together and keeping pets from being surrendered to area shelters. My long tenure has provided a deep understanding of the challenges and rewards of working in a shelter including the emotional toll, importance of community support and the impact of factors like overcrowding and limited resources.

In my 30 years I have built many strong relationships with volunteers, donors and community members who support the shelter. Other great assets are the tireless staff and board. All of you have helped us get from where we were 30 years ago, to the premier, nationally recognized shelter we are today! For this I thank all of you!

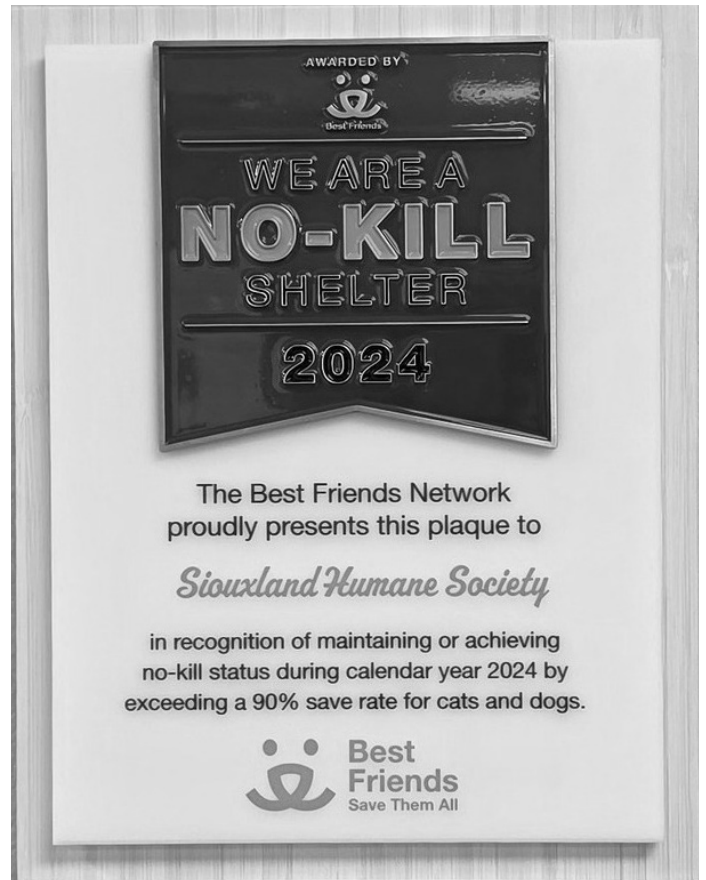

The Siouxland Humane Society received national recognition for our live release rate from the Best Friends Animal Society! A plaque was awarded for 2024, naming us one of the leading no-kill shelters in the nation!

We achieved an official save rate of 99.06% by Best Friends for 2024, far exceeding the national average of 82%. We were the only shelter/rescue in the area recognized. We have been a no-kill Shelter since 2014 with save rates exceeding the 90% benchmark annually.

This accomplishment represents so much more than a number. It represents our culture of caring and compassion. Dedicated staff and board, committed volunteers and motivated supporters. This number represents cherished family members who are only alive because of our community’s work, dedication and support.

IT'S ALREADY BEEN A BUSY YEAR!

Our pet retention services continue to help keep people, pets – families together and their pets out of area shelters. The first six months of 2025 are off to a busy start!

We have assisted 90 families with Spay/Neuter costs in the amount of \$10,362.78.

Emergency Vet Assistance has helped 87 pet owners not able to get their sick/injured pets treated by a veterinarian. We have paid out \$21,959.70 for exams and additional assistance with illnesses or injuries.

The Pet Food Bank has supplied 5463 pounds of cat and dog food to 322 families that short term could not afford to feed their pets.

Shelter Veterinary Costs & Care so far this year has been \$21,504.61 for vet care and costs for animals surrendered to us.

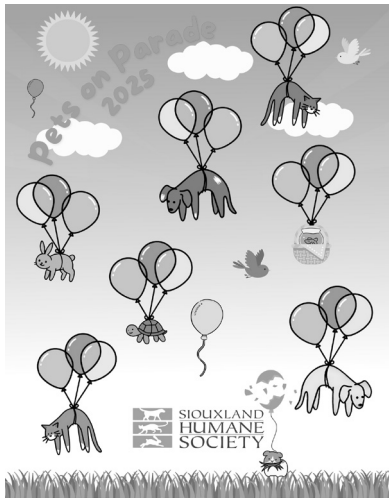
